Dear Planning Inspectorate,

Re: Development of National Significance DNS/3227364 Tycroes Solar

I write further to the consultation on DNS/3227364. The details of the submission have been reported to Carmarthenshire's Planning Committee as an information item and as a result the following two queries have been identified which are hereby being formally submitted as a representation for consideration.

- 1. That any approval of planning application DNS/3227364 should contain a condition for the provision of a detailed de-commissioning plan to incorporate:-
- The requirement for payment of a bond to ensure sufficient money was available to undertake the decommissioning works at the end of the 40 year life span in the event of the developer having ceased trading
- The safe removal/treatment/disposal of the solar panels to prevent any leakage and subsequent ground contamination to protect the land for future generations.
- 2. Consideration should be afforded to the issue of the payment of community benefits to the three local community council areas affected by the proposed development"
