Following the Welsh Government's publication on the 2nd March of its ["Beyond Recycling" strategy](#), The Inspector wishes to add some additional points for discussion to the Hearing Session 1 Agenda, as follows:

- i. What is the materiality of the newly published Welsh Government strategy document "Beyond Recycling" to the determination of the Môr Hafren DNS application?
- ii. How well does the Môr Hafren proposal fit with the published strategy and its milestones towards zero waste by 2050, including the intention to place a moratorium on all future large-scale energy from waste developments?
- iii. What implications do the strategy and milestones have for the reliable availability of an adequate supply of feedstock (200,000 tonnes pa of residual commercial/industrial waste which would otherwise go to landfill, sourced from the stated catchment area) throughout the intended lifetime of the Môr Hafren proposal?

The Inspector would like all hearing participants to include responses to these questions as part of any pre-hearing submissions.
